LaGuardia Community College and the City University of New York (“CUNY”) are committed to maintaining a safe and respectful environment in which all students may participate in organizations without being subjected to hazing as a condition of entry or membership. Hazing is strictly prohibited and is inconsistent with CUNY policy and the Rules and Regulations for the Maintenance of Public Order Pursuant to Article 129-A of the New York State Education Law - the “Henderson Rules”. New York State Law (N.Y. Penal Law §120.16) defines Hazing as follows:

“A person is guilty of hazing in the first degree when, in the course of another person's initiation into or affiliation with any organization, he intentionally or recklessly engages in conduct, including, but not limited to, making physical contact with or requiring physical activity of such other person, which creates a substantial risk of physical injury to such other person or a third person and thereby causes such injury.”

Thus, no organization affiliated with LaGuardia Community College shall engage in or condone any hazing activities.

Reporting Procedures

An individual who wishes to initiate a hazing complaint, they may do so by contacting the Public Safety Department at 718-482-5558. Complaints may also be submitted to the CUNY Office of Student Affairs at StudentAffairs@cuny.edu.

Emergency Response

In the event of an immediate threat to health or safety, individuals are advised to contact emergency services by dialing **911**.

Support Services

Any person who is a victim of hazing is strongly encouraged to contact the Wellness Center (C-249) at 718-482-5471, which can provide confidential counseling and support services.

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LaGuardia Community College can report that from July 1, 2025, through June 1, 2026, there have been no substantiated allegations of hazing involving student organizations established or recognized by the institution. Any hazing violations will be documented below, and this report will be updated every six months.
