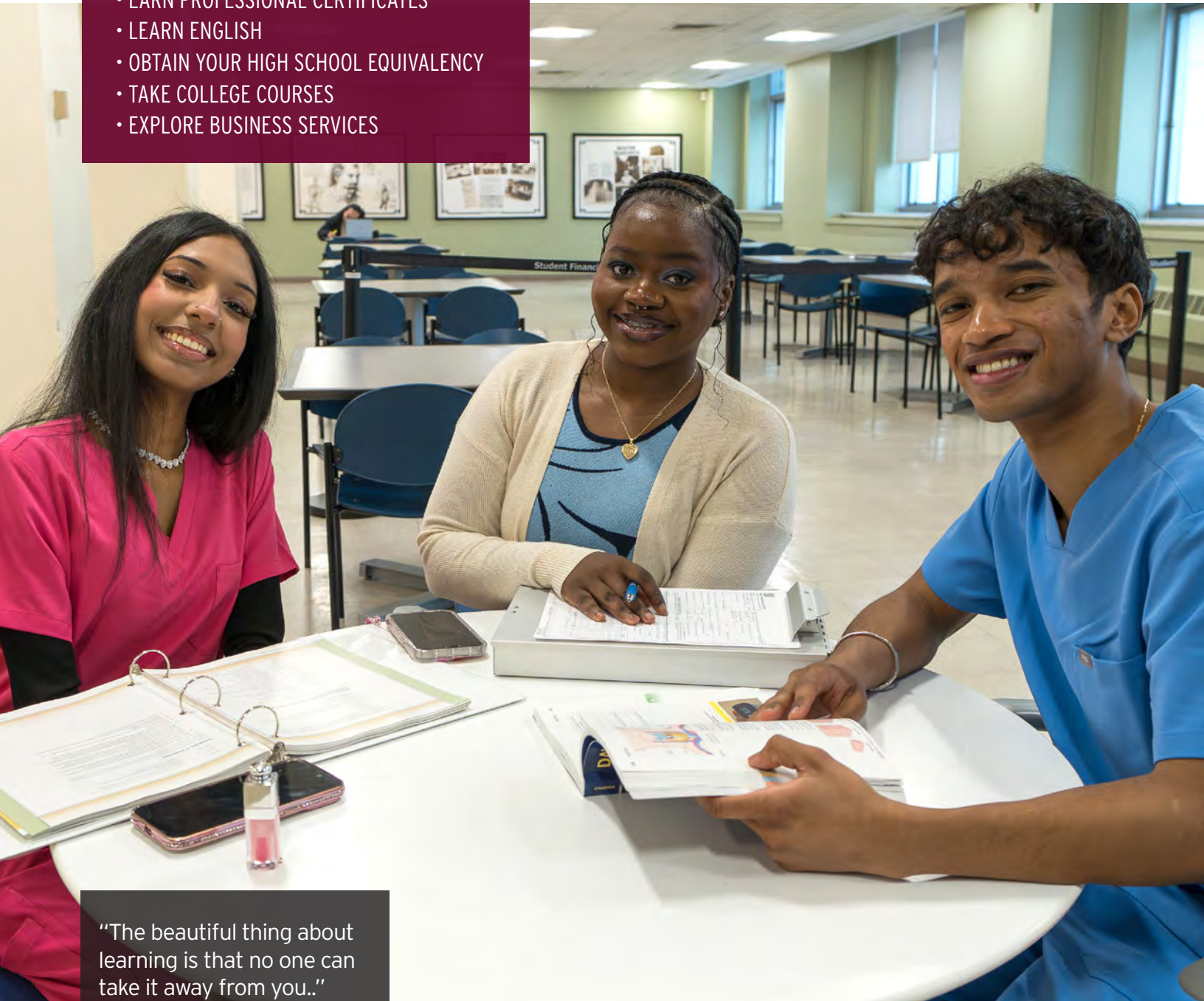

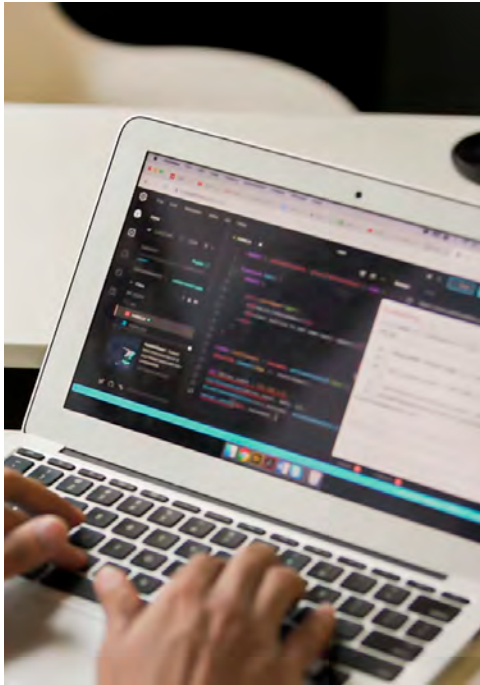

You can also earn a LaGuardia certificate in Advanced Data Analytics by completing Data Science: Introduction to Machine Learning Models. In addition, individual intermediate and advanced level courses will be offered throughout the year covering in-demand topics. These include TensorFlow Certificate Prep, Power BI, and more. Throughout the 5-course program, he learned to think more critically, improved his ability to interpret analytical results, and completed projects that deepened his understanding of how analytics can support real-world cybersecurity operations.

In addition to earning the Data Analytics Certificate and Advanced Data Analytics Certificate, Saroar also enrolled in LaGuardia's Cybersecurity Specialist course and earned that certificate as well. His goal over the next few years is to become a subject matter expert in data-driven cybersecurity analytics, building systems that detect threats, reduce risk, and support strategic decision-making. He says he now has the confidence, clarity and technical foundation to advance in that direction.

Artificial Intelligence (AI) Certification Program

In partnership with the Intel® Digital Readiness Program and utilizing Intel's innovative AI for Workforce curriculum, this series of classes empowers the current and future workforce with AI skills focused on AI employability in the digital economy.

Begin a career in the cutting-edge field of Artificial Intelligence. The Artificial Intelligence (AI) Certification Program offers a progressive learning path, starting with two foundational courses (AI Foundations I and II) that provide essential knowledge and skills in AI concepts as well as Python programming for machine learning. These courses are mandatory and must be taken in sequence. Intermediate courses (ML Infrastructure and Engineering, Computer Vision, Natural Language Processing & Generative AI, or AI for Problem-Solving) combine theoretical knowledge, practical application, and independent research packages to ensure you develop a comprehensive understanding of AI's technical and ethical dimensions. Two of the four intermediate level courses are required to complete the certification. These courses can be taken in any order and allow you to customize your learning journey according to your interests and career goals. Final projects in each course challenge you to synthesize your acquired knowledge and showcase your proficiency in real-world applications.

Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive LaGuardia Certification in Artificial Intelligence, indicating your expertise in various AI disciplines and readiness to engage with AI challenges in professional settings. Certificate program courses not offered this quarter will be offered in a future quarter. ND

AI Foundations I (Beginner)

Explore the current Artificial Intelligence (AI) landscape, its history and various AI types such as neural networks and decision trees, in this introductory course designed for individuals with little or no AI background. You will also study practical aspects of data management and learn how to evaluate and optimize AI models. Your acquired ability to communicate about AI trends and history will pave the way for continuous learning and upskilling opportunities within your organization or role. (8 weeks, 48 hours) ND

AI Foundations II (Beginner)

Delve into topics such as computational thinking, algorithm design and neural network basics. This course also highlights the importance of inclusivity and socio-emotional intelligence in AI, culminating in a project that proposes an ethical AI system. Computer Vision (Intermediate)

Tax Return Preparer

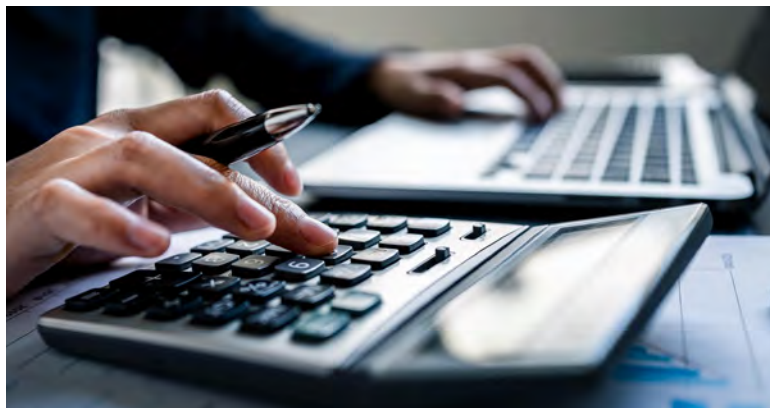

You will become familiar with the 1040 series, NYS IT 201, and wage income forms. Upon completion of this course you should be able to complete individual taxes for yourself or someone else and will earn a LaGuardia certificate of completion. No software required. Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA)

The CCMA is an essential member of the medical care team who assists the physician with procedures such as taking vital signs, preparing patients for medical procedures, and performing phlebotomy (blood drawing) and electrocardiography (EKG). To take the national certification exam for Clinical Medical Assistant, you must successfully pass all five courses in this program: Medical Terminology*, American Heart Association CPR for Healthcare Providers with First Aid*, EKG Technician*, Phlebotomy*, and CCMA Procedures. You may take the courses in any order, or you may take them individually, except CCMA Procedures. To register for CCMA Procedures, you must first successfully complete either EKG Technician or Phlebotomy.

LaGuardia's CCMA Program currently has a 98% pass rate for students taking the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) CCMA certification exam. Attendance at an orientation session and passing an online reading exam are required before registration for EKG Technician and Phlebotomy and are recommended before beginning the 5-course CCMA series. A high school diploma or equivalency is a prerequisite for NHA certifications and often a requirement for jobs in the field. CCMA program courses not offered this quarter will be offered in a future quarter. To apply, please visit www.laguardia.edu/ccma. Full and partial tuition scholarships are available for eligible students, and a separate application process is required. Contact CCMA@lagcc.cuny.edu for more information. ND

This year's winners of the **CUNY-wide Peter Jennings Laurel Award Scholarship** include four graduates of ACE's Adult Basic Skills program. Armani Chancellor, Solomon Feldman, Yousuf Imtiaz and Carolina Lapiz demonstrated commitment to their education and persistence in the face of challenges in order to qualify for the award, which is given annually to a small group of students who have earned their high school equivalency certificate from a CUNY adult literacy/high school equivalency program and who plan to continue their education at a CUNY college.

Armani wanted to break the cycle of limited opportunity that his parents faced by not earning their high school diploma. Moving from New Orleans to New York City, he worked hard at creating consistent study habits and remaining focused on his academic goals while adapting to a new environment. He has chosen journalism for his degree so that he can tell stories that will have a meaningful impact on society.

Solomon, a father of six, was determined to provide a strong example for his children and create a better future for his family. Earning his high school equivalency diploma has given him the confidence to continue his education, and he plans to study psychology or human services in order to enter a profession that helps others. Solomon has also been chosen as the speaker at the award ceremony, representing all of the scholarship winners this year.

Yousuf came to the Adult Basic Skills program as a recent immigrant from Bangladesh. Though he struggled with cultural adjustment, financial pressures and transition to academic English, he realized that education would be the key to his success. He applied himself, creating a rigorous study schedule, and persisted, even after failing one of the GED exams the first time. He earned his equivalency diploma and is now planning a future as an electrical engineer.

Finally, **Carolina** is the recipient of Peter Jennings Continuation Award. She grew up in Argentina during a time of political turmoil and eventually immigrated to the United States. After becoming a U. S. citizen and earning her high school equivalency diploma through the Adult Basic Skills program, Carolina enrolled in LaGuardia as a Psychology major and graduated. Today she is well on her way to fulfilling her dream of becoming a therapist.

This year marks the 23rd year of the Peter Jennings Laurel Award Scholarship, named for Peter Jennings, renowned journalist and anchor of ABC World News Tonight, who was himself a high school dropout. Students must be nominated by a teacher or staff member and provide a personal essay describing their journey to college. Winners each receive \$1,000 in scholarship funding towards their CUNY college education.

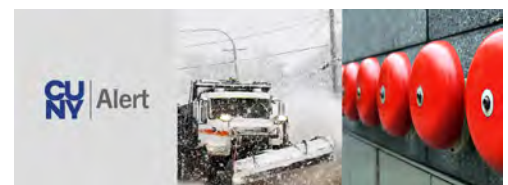

Events are open to anyone, not only CUNY students. Languages spoken: English, Spanish and Chinese.

Experienced lawyers and other immigration professionals will assist you in filling out forms if you meet all of the following naturalization requirements:

- You have resided in the United States as a permanent resident for five years (or for three years if you are married to and living with a U.S. citizen)
- You have been physically present in the United States for half of the five (or three) year period
- You are at least 18 years old

Payment is required at the time of registration. You may pay with cash or using a debit or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Discover).

Discounts

The Division of Adult & Continuing Education (ACE) offers discounts to the following groups: 30% tuition discount is offered to alumni association members, LaGuardia undergraduates, senior citizens (65+ years), faculty/staff and the families of faculty/staff. 30% tuition discount is offered to the children of undergraduates and to the children of faculty/staff. 50% tuition discount is offered to public assistance recipients. Only one discount can be applied per course. Discounts and waivers apply to all courses except those designated ND.

The date the written request is submitted will also determine a student's tuition liability for the course. Students remain responsible for all tuition and fees until an official written withdrawal and refund request is received by the ACE Enrollment Management Office.
